We've looked during these 50 Days of Transformation first at spiritual health, then at physical health and last week we looked at mental health. This week we look at emotional health, that is, how to deal with how you feel. Last week, we talked about how to manage your mind and your thoughts. Today, we look at what the Bible says about how to manage your emotions.

Mark 12:29-30 Jesus says this, ***"The most important commandment is this, You must love the Lord your God with all your heart and all your soul and all your mind and all your strength."***

Do you hear the emotion in these words of Jesus? Jesus is saying I don't want you to just kind of love me, just kind of love God. I want you to love God passionately with all your heart, all your soul, all your mind, and all your strength. God wants an emotional relationship with you. He doesn't want a head knowledge, "Yeah, I know Jesus. I know God." He wants an emotional passionate relationship that is full of feelings.
