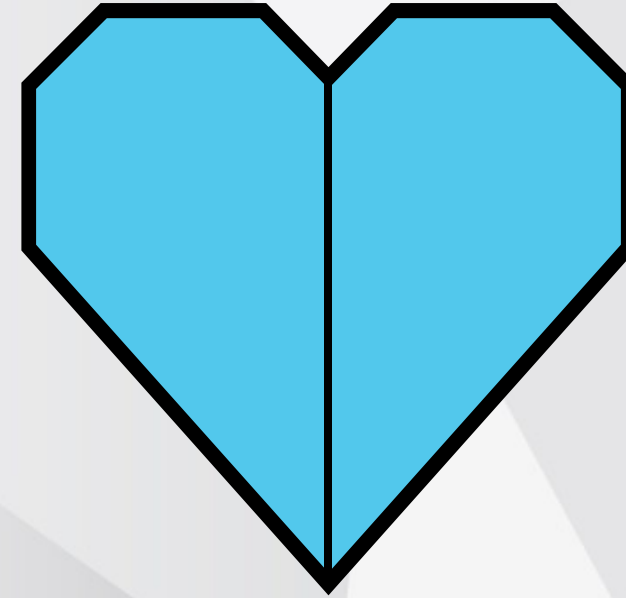

50 Days of Transformation FACING THE FEARS THAT RUIN RELATIONSHIPS

Welcome to the 50 Days of Transformation. We've been looking at transforming seven key areas of your life. We've looked at spiritual health, physical health, mental health, emotional health, and this week we look at relational health. We want to make your relationships better and diffuse the fears that ruin relationships.

To do that, we're going all the way back to the book of Genesis, the very first book of the Bible, and look at the first couple Adam and Eve because that's where all the problems started.
