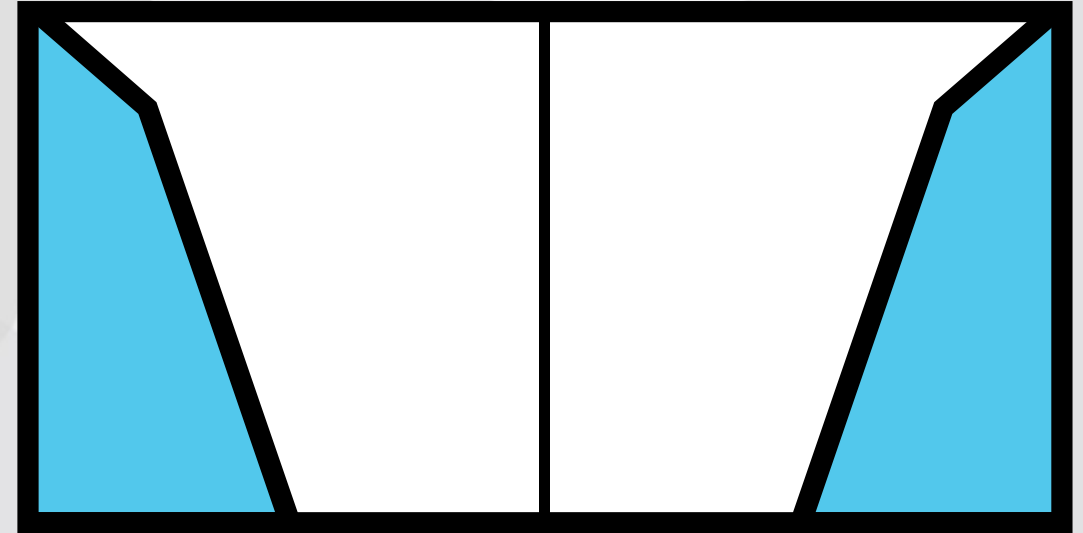

50 Days of Transformation Financial Health - Part 6

For seven weeks we're been looking at seven different dimensions of your life. We've looked at your spiritual health, physical health, mental health, emotional health and relational health. We've got two more dimensions to deal with - work and money. Today, we'll look at financial health.

It may surprise you that Jesus actually talked more about money than he did about heaven or hell. In fact, half of all of the parables that Jesus told are about money. In the books of Matthew, Mark and Luke, one out of every six verses is about money and money management.

Why? Because money can dominate our lives and money influences our lives for either good or bad. It can be used for great things. It can be used for bad things. We spend so much of our time thinking about it, working for it, earning it, studying it, saving it and investing it - all of these different things. If you don't learn to manage your money, it will manage you.
