

Inductive Bible Study Guide

We want you to get the most out of these daily devotions. To do that, we have outlined some steps that we believe will help you maximize your time with God (through an approach known as Inductive Bible Study).

If you are in need of a good study Bible, Pastor Keith recommends the "Life Application Study Bible" in either the NLT or NIV versions. You can find them online or at your local Christian bookstore.

Allow these steps to guide you as you approach God's Word in your daily quiet time with your Heavenly Father.

Step One: Observation — What does the verse say?

- Ask "Who, What, Where, When, How" questions
- Look for repeated words, lists and themes
- Pay attention to causal connections such as "but, therefore, as and because"
- Notice any contrasts and comparisons

Step Two: Interpretation — What does it mean?

- What is the author's intent?
- How would the original audience understand it?
- What was the historical context?
- What are the connections with passages before/after?

Step Three: Application — How does it apply to my life?

- Is there a promise to encourage/strengthen me?
- Did I see something about God's character? Is there a command to obey?
- How can I pray these truths into my life?

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
